Sadiq Khan was elected Mayor of London in May this year, winning the biggest personal mandate in the history of British politics. Before this, Sadiq had a distinguished Parliamentary career as the Member of Parliament for Tooting, a constituency in south London. He served as a Minister in the Department for Communities and Local Government and the Department for Transport, becoming the first Muslim to attend Cabinet. He later served as the Shadow Secretary of State for Justice and the Shadow Minister for London.

Sadiq was born and raised in London after his parents moved to England from Pakistan in the 1960s. His father worked as a bus driver and the family lived on a council estate (housing project). Before entering politics and public service, Sadiq studied law at university and was a respected human rights lawyer for over 10 years, helping to build a firm of 50 employees.



Frederick H. Waddell is Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Northern Trust, one of the world's leading asset management, asset servicing, fund administration, fiduciary and banking services firms. Serving successful individuals, families and institutions worldwide, the Chicago-based, 122-year-old financial institution had \$4.2 trillion in assets under custody and \$644.2 billion in assets under management as of September 30, 2011.

Since joining Northern Trust in 1975, Waddell has held leadership positions in Commercial Banking, Strategic Planning and Personal Financial Services. In March 2003, he became head of the Corporate & Institutional Services

business unit and, in February 2006, was named President and Chief Operating Officer of Northern Trust. Mr. Waddell was appointed Chief Executive Officer on January 1, 2008, and named Chairman in November 2009.

Waddell is a member of the Board of Directors of the Federal Reserve Bank of Chicago, The Chicago Council on Global Affairs, The Economic Club of Chicago, the Financial Services Roundtable, The Chicago Club, Chicago Urban League and the United Way of Metropolitan Chicago. He is a member of the Commercial Club of Chicago and the Civic Committee of the Chicago Commonwealth Club. He is on the Board of Trustees of the Art Institute of Chicago, Northwestern University, the Chicago Symphony Orchestra and Northwestern Memorial Hospital. He also serves on the Trustees Committee of the Chicago Community Trust. Mr. Waddell serves as Vice Chairman of the Corporate Fund Board of the John F. Kennedy Center and is an Executive Advisor to the Metropolitan Planning Council.

Waddell received a bachelor's degree in government from Dartmouth College and a master's degree in business administration from the J.L. Kellogg School of Management of Northwestern University.



Sheila Penrose has served on five corporate boards and chaired a number of different board committees over the last 15 years across a variety of industries, all brand leaders in their fields. She is currently a Director of three companies: McDonald's, JLL (Jones Lang LaSalle), where she has been Chairman of the Board since 2005, and Entrust Datacard.

With experience across the investor community, M&A, financial management and global expansion, Sheila was a 2014 finalist for the Chairman of the Year award by NYSE Governance Services.

Ms. Penrose serves on the steering committee of the World Economic Forum (Davos) Community of Corporate Board Chairmen, as well as its Gender Equity initiative. Her commitment to diversity and inclusion is evidenced as a founding member of the US 30% Club, as well as her years on the Advisory Board of Catalyst, the C200 Board and the board of The Chicago Network.

Sheila co-founded and co-chairs Corporate Leadership Center, which partners with F500 companies and leading business schools to augment and accelerate the leadership development of senior executives through the CEO Perspectives and Leading Women Executives programs.

Before serving as Executive Advisor to Boston Consulting Group, Sheila was the first woman member of Northern Trust Corporation's Management Committee as President of the Corporate Bank. Under her leadership, this global business was transformed from a product organization to one organized around client segments, and net income grew 17% annually during her tenure.

Before moving to the United States, Sheila was Economic Advisor at the British Treasury, focusing on budget policy.

Sheila began her career in education, serving as Lecturer in Economics at Central London Polytechnic. With a degree in economics and a graduate diploma in education from the University of Birmingham in England, as well as a master's degree from London School of Economics, Sheila attended the Executive Program at Stanford Graduate School of Business, where she later served on the Advisory Board.



Dr Azeem Ibrahim is a Fellow at Mansfield College, University of Oxford and Research Professor at the Strategic Studies Institute, US Army War College. He received his PhD from the University of Cambridge and has previously been appointed an International Security Fellow at the Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University and a World Fellow at Yale University.

Over the years, Dr Ibrahim has met and advised numerous world leaders on policy development. In his most recent roles, he served as National Security and Defence Policy Advisor to the Leader of the (UK) Labour Party, Rt Hon Ed Miliband MP, and the Shadow Cabinet from 2012 to 2015, and as Strategic Policy Advisor to the Chairman of Pakistan's PTI party, Imran Khan.

Outside academia, Dr Ibrahim has been a reservist in the IV Battalion Parachute Regiment (UK's elite airborne infantry reserve) and a multi-award winning entrepreneur. He was ranked as a Top 100 Global Thinker by the European Social Think Tank in 2010 and named a Young Global Leader by the World Economic Forum.
